

Babysitting Safety



This (approx.) 5 hour course is geared for teens wishing to learn the essentials for providing safe, effective care of children and infants.

The *Child and Babysitting Safety* training program is designed to focus on supervising, caring for, and keeping children and infants safe in babysitting settings. The program provides fundamental information in the business of babysitting, proper supervision, basic caregiving skills, and responding properly to ill or injured children or infants.

Babysitting is usually a teenager's first attempt at building and running a small business. This course is designed to engage and inform the aspiring babysitter. It gives teenagers everything they need to know, from getting started, to dealing with parents and children, to key safety, caregiving, and first aid tips.

Intended Audience
